Federal Nutrition Programs

SNAP

- Federal nutrition program with monthly funds on a debit-like EBT card to buy food
- Eligibility: Dependent on who is in the household, income and certain expenses, you must also be a US citizen
- Where to Apply: www.mass.gov/how-to/apply-for-snap-benefits-food-stamps

WIC

- Health and nutrition program for pregnant women, breastfeeding women, up to 1 year postpartum, non-breastfeeding women, up to 6 months postpartum and infants and children younger than age 5
- Eligibility: must live in Massachusetts, have a nutritional need (determined by WIC staff), are a child under 5, a new mom or a pregnant or breastfeeding woman, and have a family income less than WIC guidelines
- You are automatically income eligible for WIC if you currently receive MassHealth/Medicaid insurance plans, Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP), Transitional Aid to Families with Dependent Children (TAFDC) or cash assistance

National School Lunch Program

- All schools participating in the NSLP, provide students with free school lunch
- This includes all public schools and some charter schools. Breakfast and a snack is also available at some schools

Summer Eats (Summer Food Service Program (SFSP))

- Summer Eats provides free meals for youth ages 0-18 during the summer months, Monday through Friday
